Outstanding Student Librarian Award

I. Determination Of Award

- A. The applicant must be enrolled in a college or university majoring in library science
- B. The applicant must have a 3.0 grade point average
- C. The applicant must demonstrate outstanding leadership qualities and has the potential to be a future leader in PSLA
- D. The applicant must demonstrate an interest in professional action
- E. The applicant must show dedication to the field of school library as a profession
- F. The applicant must have graduated in December of the year following the award or is finishing in May of the year the award is given.

II. Application Process

- A. Each college/university must submit the following information in order for the nominee to be eligible for consideration for this award.
 - 1. Name of nominating college/university
 - 2. Name of nominating individual and contact information
 - 3. Name of nominee and contact information

III. Selection of Award

- A. The winners are chosen by the college/university and submitted to the PSLA Students Committee.
- B. The winners are reviewed by PSLA Board

IV. Presentation of Award

- A. The award will be presented to one graduate and one undergraduate student in each library program in the Commonwealth during the Annual Conference.
- B. Each winner will receive:
 - 1. One full conference registration without meals or hotels
 - 2. One-year membership to PSLA
