

PSLA Presidential Award

I. Authority

The PSLA Presidential Award may be given at the discretion of the PSLA President to an individual or group who has had a significant impact on school libraries and students.

II. Requirement

The recipient cannot have been a school librarian within the previous 5 years.

III. Procedure and Presentation

A. It is at the discretion of the current PSLA President to determine if the PSLA Presidential Award will be awarded during his or her term.

B. The award recipient will be proposed by the PSLA President and approved by the Board.

C. The recipient will be recognized at the PSLA Annual Conference or at another time, if the recipient is not available.
